

Travel grants for Early Career Researchers - call for applications -

In cooperation with the International Arctic Science Committee (IASC), we are pleased to announce the availability of **travel support** for the "International MOSAiC Science Conference 2024 - Transition to Sustained Arctic System Science" taking place from **26 February - 01 March 2023** in Potsdam (Germany).

1. Who can apply?

Early career researchers up to 7 years past PhD who is actively participating in the conference by submitting an abstract for an oral or poster presentation. Note: this 7 year definition for ECR is an extension beyond the typical 5 year definition to help accommodate career challenges related to COVID and other issues in the past few years.

2. Amount of funding

Travel support is given for **travel costs only not for daily meals**. The costs will be reimbursed after the meeting based on receipts, which you provide. Pre-travel reimbursement is not possible. Please consider budget-friendly reservations as this allows us to fund as many ECRs as possible.

3. Application procedure

Please submit your application via the attached form no later than **11 December 2023 at 06:00 UTC**. Late applications will not be considered. The MOSAiC office will coordinate the evaluation and allocation of the funds. Your application will be evaluated solely on the information you provide via the form. We will not accept other material via email (unless you are asked to do so). Please answer all the questions as completely as possible.
